Two weeks ago my mom was diagnosed with stage 3C ovarian cancer that has metastasized to her abdomen.

They have already started chemo and she will have major surgery near the end of the year followed by more chemotherapy. My mom is a strong Christian, with a beautiful, fierce faith, and walking through the beginning of this scary, sudden, painful process with her has been such a clear picture of God with us. Even though the whole situation is almost constantly on my mind, God has used that to call me into a continuous stream of prayer like never before, and though I have been sad and even grieved over what may come, I have not had a single moment of feeling overwhelmed or helpless or even worried. God has flooded my heart with His peace. As I have been sharing the situation with friends here (many non-Christians), God has opened doors for me to share little glimpses of who He is and how He works. We are praying for her healing. I can't imagine life without my mom. We are thanking God for this reminder that time is precious, and we are praying for every person that He will bring into our lives during this journey. Love, Emily
